# THE RULE OF THIRDS

Use the grid for 'the rule of thirds'.  
This is quite useful to line your  
subjects in order to get a more  
attractive image.

AE / AF LOCK



# LOCK YOUR FOCUS POINT

Just hold your finger on the object you want to set sharp and wait until the AE/AF lock turns on. This is especially useful for any form of macro photography.



# NEVER USE THE FLASH ON YOUR PHONE

They are still (yes even in 2020)  
not strong enough to give a  
sufficient light source for your  
photos.

# LOOK FOR LEADING LINES

These lines draw the viewer's eye in a specific direction or towards an object in the photo.



# USE THE VOLUME BUTTON

When snapping a photo in landscape, try to use the volume button instead of the digital shutter. This way you can hold both hands on your camera for a stable shot and a more sharp result.
